
How many words? Where are the finger spaces? Can you find our new sound 'Z'?





Say and segment the word 'zap' using robot talk. Can the children find the letters needed and put them in the correct order? Children to read the word they made and check if it says 'zap'.

If the word has the Z sound in it, then your child needs to walk along the scarf Z.
